

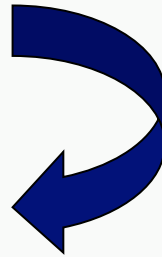

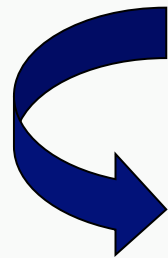

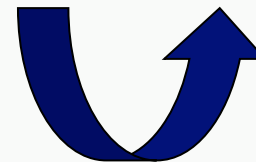

PURPOSE OF FEMA'S MASS EVACUATION

- **EVACUATE 40,000 TO 65,000 EVACUEES
AND THEIR PETS 24 TO 12 HOURS OF
LANDFALL**
- **EVACUATE TO AIRPORTS WITHIN 500
MILES OF THE AFFECTED CITY**
- **RETURN EVACUEES TO AFFECTED AREA
IF THERE IS NOT CATASTROPHIC DAMAGE**

- ENHANCE FEMA'S ABILITY TO CONDUCT
MASS AIR EVACUATIONS**
- EXPLORE AVAILABLE OPTIONS OF THE

AND PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS**

CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

➤ **STARTING POINT OF EVACUATION**

➤ **ACTIVITIES AT THE EVACUATION SITE**

➤ **TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT / FLOW**

➤ **DEBARKATION OF 10,000-15,000
EVACUEES TO 4 DIFFERENT AIRPORTS
WITHIN 500 MILES OF AFFECTED CITY**

➤ **RETURN EVACUEES TO AFFECTED AREA**

COMMENTS FROM WORK GROUPS IN ATTENDANCE

- **FAA IS NOT LIKELY TO RELAX FAR'S FOR
EVACUATION PURPOSES**

- **AFFECTED AIRPORTS WOULD BE
BUTTONING UP HATCHES IN PREPARATION
FOR THE IMPENDING HURRICANE**

- **NO PLAN FOR FUEL ACQUISITION**

- **MASS EVACUATION AIRLIFTS REQUIRE A
SIGNIFICANT AMOUNT OF PLANNING AND
LOGISTICS**
